3. Teach us to num-ber our days a - right, that we may gain wis - dom of heart.



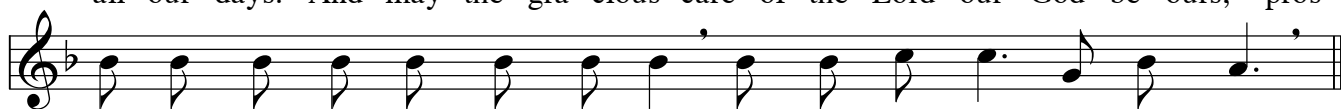
